PRIVACY POLICY worldlotterysummit.org, Website dedicated to the World Lottery Summit 2026

Preamble:

This Privacy Policy or Data Protection Statement (hereinafter, the “DPS”) applies to the processing of personal data collected by the World Lottery Association (hereinafter, “WLA”, “We” or “Us”) in connection with its website www.worldlotterysummit.org, and promotional activities.

The DPS provides essential information regarding the personal data processed by WLA, the purposes for which such data is processed, and the potential recipients of the data.

1. Who is responsible for processing your personal data

The data controller is the entity that determines the purposes and means of processing your personal data.

The data controller for the personal data collected on the Website is:

World Lottery Association – WLA

incorporated in Switzerland as a Non-profit Organization, having its registered offices at Avenue de Provence, 14 – 1007 Lausanne – Switzerland, acting in the name and on behalf of its brand World Lottery Summit / WLS (hereinafter the “WLA” or “We” or “Us”).

This DPS was last updated on April 15, 2026

2. What personal data do We collect

We collect personal data that you provide to Us, such as by filling out a registration form, a tradeshow registration form, networking event and/or Awards submission

Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. This includes, but is not limited to, first and last name, telephone number, postal and email address, date of birth, company, job title and similar information.

In addition, We may collect:

- dietary requirements,
- credit card details for payment purposes only;
- passport details for Visa application purpose only.

We collect metadata, for example details of your visits to the Website, such as traffic data,

location data, IP address, browser information, session data, preferences, settings, weblogs and other communication data, which we monitor during your interaction with the Website.

3. On what basis do We process your personal data

We process your personal data for the purposes indicated or obvious at the time of collection and:

- to which you have agreed, for example by checking a box;
- or for which We are required by applicable laws, for example to comply with data retention requirements;
- or which is necessary for the performance of a contract;
- or for which We rely on other legitimate interests,

4. For what purposes do We process your personal data?

We process your personal data only for purposes that are necessary for the provision of our services, the management of your account or participation, the management of your registration, communication with you, and compliance with legal obligations.

We process your personal data also to comply with and enforce applicable legal requirements, relevant industry standards, contractual obligations and our policies.

We process metadata that We collect from you to improve our Website, analyze traffic pattern and Website usage, for targeted marketing, to develop and analyze statistics and demographics, or optimize our online presence and marketing efforts.

5. Disclosure of your personal data

We may disclose your personal data if We are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms and conditions and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of the WLA or any members of the WLA, our customers, or others.

This includes exchanging data with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

We may internationally transfer your personal data, including to countries that are not considered providing an adequate level of data protection by the relevant regulatory bodies, for example to countries not considered by the Swiss Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner or the European Commission to be providing such level. In such case, We ensure the adequate protection of your personal data by having the recipients adhere to binding contractual obligations in accordance with applicable standards approved by the relevant regulatory bodies or by relying on other safeguards, such as self-certifications (e.g. Swiss and EU Privacy Shield), approved by the relevant regulatory bodies. You may contact Us for a copy of the contractual and other safeguards in place.

6. How long is the collected data retained

We process your personal data:

- until you withdraw your consent for future processing;
- until the purpose is fulfilled for which your data was originally collected (e.g. tracking website traffic);
- for as long as laws require Us, e.g. legal retention obligations based on bookkeeping or tax laws and regulations;
- for as long as We have any other legitimate interest in processing your personal data.

7. Data subject rights

Under the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP), you have the following rights concerning your personal data:

Right of Access – You can request confirmation as to whether your personal data is being processed and, if so, access to that data.

Right to Rectification – You may request correction of inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

Right to Deletion – You may request the deletion of personal data that is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

Right to Object – You can object to the processing of your personal data, in particular for marketing purposes.

Right to Withdraw Consent – If you have consented to the processing of your data, you may withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing prior to the withdrawal.

Right to Lodge a Complaint – You can lodge a complaint with the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner (FDPIC) if you believe your data protection rights have been violated.
